About R.E.A.C.H

R.E.A.C.H Summer Day Camp is a collaboration between Oyster River Cooperative School District (ORCSD) and Durham Parks & Recreation Department (DPR) to provide unique and engaging camp opportunities for ORCSD students. R.E.A.C.H is a community-based summer camp experience for local youth, which runs Monday-Thursday (plus optional Friday Field Trips).

Campers can participate in a morning ORCSD REACH Camp, and then have the option to transition to afternoon camp with DPR. Registration is separate for morning camp, afternoon camp and Friday Field Trips each week.

School lunch is available Mon-Thur from 11:30am-12:00pm for all school age children.

Campers can select from a list of camps from art, nature, STEM, dance, sports, & more! Morning camps are designed to be age appropriate with specific grade ranges indicated on the registration.

-Camp registrations cancelled between **6/1-8/2 with a 2-week notice** receive 50% credit only on your Recdesk account.

Camp Title	Description
Upcycled Art <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Come make art using recycled materials. We will use paper towel rolls, bottles, bottle caps, and other recycled materials to create a masterpiece.
Slime Week <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Join us for some messy fun! We will be exploring various materials with our senses and make different types of slime including cloud slime, crunchy slime, galaxy slime and many more.
Ocean Week <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Do you enjoy learning about ocean animals? In this camp we will explore various animals that live in the ocean. We will make ocean animal crafts, read stories, learn facts, practice ocean animal yoga poses and much more.
Bead Week <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Join us in exploring all sorts of beautiful, colorful beads to create various wearable and collectible crafts. We will make bracelets, necklaces, various animals and much more. I look forward to seeing what you can create!
Primary Color Week <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Come learn what the primary colors are all about. We will explore books to learn about what happens when we mix them and then create lots of fun crafts that help us understand how they work together. Let's get our hands messy with paper spinners, bubble paint, and playdough. We'll even experiment with colored ice!
Artsy Antics <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Time to get messy! Join us for a week full of creative exploration with paint, palettes, brushes, and more! In this camp we will be trying out some fun and unique painting techniques. We will explore how to create abstract scrape paintings, how to play with perspective, how to use texture tools, and even how to paint a family pet or favorite character! Everyone will get a chance to use their imagination, learn some new art skills, and create their own masterpieces to take home. Come paint with us!

Lego WeDo 2.0 <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	In this interactive camp, children will learn about robots, gears, sensors, and simple programming while building various Lego characters, vehicles, and other structures. Then, following step-by-step directions, campers will learn how to use drag-and drop coding that makes it fun and easy to bring their creations to life.
Outdoor Fun <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Prepare for some fun in the sun! We will be playing a variety of creative and fun games that focus on teamwork and sportsmanship. This camp is geared towards those who enjoy being active, trying new things, engaging in cooperative play, and just enjoy being outside. Sneakers, a snack, sunscreen, and a water bottle are highly encouraged.
Indoor Games & Activities <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	If you like a little fun competition or simply just enjoy playing games, you'll have plenty of fun in this camp! There will be many classic games; Chess/Checkers, Backgammon, Chinese Checkers, Othello, Shutes and Ladders, Uno, Sorry, Tri-Ominos and many other newer games like Sleeping Princess and Ticket to Ride. Sticker art, canvas painting, and arts and crafts will be sprinkled into the fun. Have a favorite game at home? Bring it in to share. There will be a Prize Box for all participants!
Elite Feet <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Ready to bust a move? Then you are in the perfect place! Elite Feet is back for its 4th year! Dancers will be doing a variety of movement activities that correspond with the different themes for each week. The Elite Feet dancers will come together on Thursday for an end of week recital that parents can attend. Wear comfortable clothing and have shoes you can dance in. Most importantly though, make sure you always bring your smile and those elite feet! See you soon!
Let's Go Fly a Kite! <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	In this hands-on camp, campers will make and fly their own kites, as well as windsocks and airplanes. Enjoy watching your handmade, one of a kind, creations fly high in the sky!
Boom Science Camp <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Boom Science camp will excite young minds into exploring the world of science through the eyes of a young scientist. We will blow things up and make them go BOOM!, set things on fire, look at creatures we find with microscopes, become field scientists in the woods, and create chemical reactions back in the lab. This engaging camp is focused on safety as a top priority...and of course loads of fun!
Oyster River Olympics <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Come participate in the Oyster River Olympics! We will spend time learning about the Summer Olympics being held in Paris this year, and then participate in our own version of the Olympics. Sprinkled in will be some of your favorite games from PE class!
Creative Kids <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	It's time for some summer fun! Creative Kids is back for its 4th year! Come join Creative Kids where we will be playing outdoor games, making arts and crafts, dancing, enjoying story time, and more. In Creative Kids, this is your time to have fun and let your creative side show! I look forward to seeing you all soon!
Wilderness <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	In this camp, children will explore the outside world and learn wilderness skills. They will participate in fort building, problem-solving games, trail building and maintenance, nature art, and plant identification. Each day, we will explore the trail to see what inspires us and use free play to practice our skills in nature. We will talk about what mindfulness in nature looks like by participating in 'sit-spots' and reflect on our senses and what we notice.
Explore the World of The Littles <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Calling all Explorers! Join us for a week of crafts, games, recipes, and fun - all themed around the series The Littles by John Peterson. Haven't read it yet? No problem! This week is all about doing activities related to the book, no experience necessary. Get ready to be creative!
Explore the World of Bad Kitty <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Calling all Explorers! Join us for a week of crafts, games, recipes, and fun - all themed around the series Bad Kitty by Nick Bruel. Haven't read it yet? No problem! This week is all about doing activities related to the book, no experience necessary. Get ready for crazy shenanigans!
Field Hockey Skills & Team Building <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Join us for a fun session of field hockey skills, small-sided scrimmages and team building activities. The day will be broken up with skills and drills, a snack break, fun team building crafts and activities, and small-sided scrimmages.

Explore the World of Keeper of the Lost Cities <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Calling all Elves! Join us for a week of crafts, games, recipes, and fun - all themed around the series Keeper of the Lost Cities by Shannon Messenger. Haven't read it yet? No problem! This week is all about doing activities related to the book, no experience necessary. Get ready to be transported!
Explore the World of Harry Potter <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Calling all witches and wizards! Join us for a week of crafts, games, recipes, and fun - all themed around the Harry Potter series by J.K. Rowling. Haven't read it yet? No problem! This week is all about doing activities related to the book, no experience necessary. Get ready for magic!
Dance Camp <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Are you a dancer? Do you love to make up dances and be creative? Join Dance Camp and spend your summer dancing with friends! From Jazz to Hip Hop, and today's pop music we will dance to it all!
Basketball Olympics (Girls) <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Join Coach G (ORMS Girls' Varsity Basketball Coach) and some outstanding ORHS basketball players for the first Girls' Oyster River Basketball Olympics! We will work on basketball fundamentals while competing in a wide range of conventional and unconventional basketball events to earn points to win Basketball Olympic medals! Events include – Dribble Races, Shooting Competitions, Rebounding Tournament, Tournaments of 1v1, 2v2, 3v3, Obstacle Course, Basketball Bowling, and many more! This is open to any skill level player who wants to work on their skills and have fun this summer!
Flour Power Baking <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Campers will make a variety of sweet and savory goodies. Campers will be given creative freedom to experiment on their own while learning the fundamentals of baking. Recipes to share will be provided! Please notify me of any allergies prior to the start of camp.
Metal Smithing <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Campers will learn how to work with a variety of different metals including copper and silver. We will be learning hammering techniques and other ways to work with metal. We will also learn how to solder metal with a torch. You will be completing some beautiful pieces!
Explore Watercolors <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	During this course students will learn watercolor techniques and how to use the art medium. Each day students will work on a painting of the day and campers will have time to paint subjects of their choice. This is your camp if you love to paint!!
Middle School Summer Musical <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	The Lion King! If you just can't wait to be part of a play, come join us for a two-week drama camp to produce The Lion King. We will gather and audition on the first day of camp. Every student will participate in the production of this 30-minute musical. We will spend camp days learning blocking, choreography, and music, as well as playing some fun theatre games. This two-week camp will culminate with a performance for friends and family!
Middle School Field Hockey Pre-Season Prep <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	This camp will focus on improving skills and endurance for the middle school field hockey season! Campers will have fun developing their field hockey IQ, as well as team building exercises. Skills, small-sided scrimmages, and team building exercises will allow players to become the best they can be on and off the field! This camp is open to field players as well as goalkeepers.
Song Writing <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	We will use elements of songwriting (form, melody, harmony, rhythm, and lyrics) to work together in groups to make some original music! Song writing is often a collaborative process, and together we will bring our creative ideas to life. Musical experience is welcomed but not required. Join David Geschwendt who has written, produced, and recorded over a hundred songs for various artists (you likely never heard of) in the genres of Pop, Rock, Indie, Country, Hip Hop, Electronic, Film Soundtrack, Jazz, Choral, and others.
Movie Making <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Are you interested in acting, directing, or filming? Come be part of a creative, fun team and learn how to make movies with iMovie.
Writer's Workshop <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	What better way to spend the beautiful summer months than by getting in touch with nature and getting in touch with our inner author? At Writer's Workshop, we try to nurture and inspire young and beginner writers to hone their work and find their voice, while making sure to have plenty of fun along the way. Campers will be treated as growing writers in a workshop setting. They will be writing, sharing, offering feedback, and developing the skills

	of accomplished writers! Each week will have a primary focus (such as poetry, fiction, personal writing, journalism, etc.) but campers will be encouraged to write about whatever interests them! The main goal is that campers enjoy the experience of writing and grow more comfortable sharing their work and expressing themselves.
Chemistry Camp <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Bring your curiosity to Chemistry Camp this summer! We will have fun with hands-on experiments as we ask questions, make observations, and do science!
Soccer Camp <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Low-Key Tekky: To be a "tekky," soccer player, is to have all the technical foot skills in your duffel bag. At Low-key Tekky, a week's worth of touches on the ball will help get you there. At Tekky camp, we'll have plenty of fun playing small-sided games, picking up pointers along the way.
