R.E.A.C.H. Camp Refund Policy

- Camp registrations cancelled between 2/18-4/30 will receive 100% refund or 100% credit on Recdesk account.
- Camp registrations cancelled between 5/1-5/31 will receive 50% refund or a 50% credit on Recdesk account.
- Camp registrations cancelled between 6/1-8/21 with 2-week notice receive 50% credit only on Recdesk account.
- Camp registrations cancelled between 6/1-8/21 without a 2-week notice will NOT be given a refund or credit.

STEMBots Summer Expedition <i>Grades: 1st to 2nd</i> <i>Grades: 3rd to 4th</i>	Campers will explore a variety of robots that may include LEGO Spike, LEGO WeDo, Ozobot, & Dash through hands-on activities. Each day, students will take on new challenges that build problem-solving, teamwork, & creativity. They'll learn how different robots work, how to code them, & how to use engineering thinking to complete missions. Designed to be fun, engaging, and accessible for all learners, whether they are brand-new to robotics or already enthusiastic builders.
Barbie Architects <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Use your creativity to design a Barbie dream room with furniture, accessories, clothing, & more. We'll be using new & recycled materials. Try making mini pieces of art for the walls or picking a theme for your room. Put up wallpaper, install rugs, or even create a custom window view to make your design truly special! Don't forget to bring a Barbie or two.
Disney Magic <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	A magical Disney-themed week full of arts & craft projects, games, music, dancing, & fun surprises along the way! Campers will get to decorate their own mouse ear headband, participate in Disney-style pin trading, & spend the week with their favorite Disney characters. Each day will be filled with creativity, imagination, & plenty of Disney magic.
Enchanted Village Fairy Houses <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Our enchanted village is a magical place where imagination leads the way and tiny wonders come to life. Wilderness Camp <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i>	Explore the forest for a week through immersive adventures and games. We will learn about wild plants and how to safely explore the woods. Sweet Tooth <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i> <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Let's get creative in the kitchen! Join us for decorating sweet treats like sugar cookies, cupcakes, cake pops and more. We will learn the basics of decorating, practicing different icing techniques, and chocolate dipping, to create our own delicious masterpieces to taste and take home. **Recipes contain gluten, please let me know of any other food allergies**
Fiber Art <i>Grades: 1st to 4th</i> <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Get ready to cut, stitch, glue, weave, and create! We will craft and explore yarn, felt, fabric, and string while making fun projects like small stuffies and colorful decorations to take home. This beginner friendly camp is all about creativity, imagination, and hands on fun (with plenty of guidance and room to make each project your own). Come ready to design and experiment and leave with crafts you'll be proud to show off.
Feathered Friends <i>Grades: 3rd to 8th</i>	Discover some of New Hampshire's common, native bird species. We will learn to identify different species through sight and sound. We will have daily birdwatching excursions throughout the school grounds to put our knowledge into practice. We will also be making crafts, such as different kinds of feeders to attract birds to your own yards.
Exploring the World of Color <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Come join us for a hands-on STEM experience where we will investigate how light, pigments, and materials interact to create the colors we see. Through experiments and creative projects we will discover the science behind color and its role in our everyday life.
Discover Cricket: The World's #2 Sport <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Learn the basics of batting, bowling, and fielding through fun games, drills, and activities. The wide cricket bat makes hitting easy, so you'll be scoring runs in no time! Led by a British coach with a love for the game, this camp will have you hooked on cricket from the first swing. Join us and find out why this sport is loved by billions around the world.
Cardboard Crafts <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Can you build a chair out of cardboard that you can actually sit on? Campers will learn how to design, plan, and build a sturdy cardboard chair. The week begins with hands-on design and problem-solving, followed by planning, building, testing, and improving their creations.

If any campers have a favorite table game that they'd like to bring in to play, feel free!
VEX IQ Beginner Robotics Camp <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	This camp is perfect for students who are new to robotics or those who are looking to learn the fundamentals. In this beginner-friendly camp, students will explore the brand-new VEX IQ Challenge while learning the basics of building, mechanical advantage, and coding, including the use of sensors. Campers will work together to brainstorm ideas, design simple robots, and test their creations in a supportive, low-pressure environment. This camp is a great way to build confidence, develop problem-solving skills, and develop robotics skills.
Stop Motion Animation <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	Let's work together to bring your stories to life! Everyone is welcome, from beginners to more advanced creators. We will work hands-on with animation tools & materials, learning how to plan, film, & edit short stop motion films. More experienced creators will have opportunities to refine their skills, experiment with various techniques, and take creative risks. Cameras and laptops will be provided for use in school. The camp emphasizes creativity, collaboration, and problem-solving in a supportive environment. Campers will create and share their projects with their fellow filmmakers.
The Science of Season <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	We invite you to come and explore the wonders happening right outside our doors. This engaging STEM program blends hands-on experiments, real-world observations, and creative problem-solving to uncover how weather, climate, plants, and animals respond to seasonal change. We will connect scientific concepts to our everyday environment, building curiosity, confidence, and a deeper appreciation for the natural world.
Watercolor Explores <i>Grades: 5th to 8th</i>	In this fun and creative class, students will discover the magic of watercolor painting! Students will learn basic watercolor techniques such as color mixing, brush control, wet-on-wet painting, and creating textures. Through guided projects and open-ended exploration, young artists will paint landscapes, animals, and imaginative scenes while building confidence in their artistic choices. The class encourages creativity, self-expression!
