Rules & Information



Welcome to the Jackson's Landing Community Kayak & Paddleboard Rack!
We're excited to offer seasonal storage to help make it easier for residents to enjoy the Oyster River & Great Bay. Please help us keep this program safe, organized, and enjoyable for everyone by following these guidelines.

Before You Store Your Watercraft

- ✓ Use **only your assigned rack space**.
- ✓ Secure your kayak or paddleboard with **your own lock**.
- ✓ Store **one (1) watercraft per assigned rack**, unless otherwise authorized.
- ✓ Make sure your contact information remains current with Durham Parks & Recreation.

While Using the Racks

Please:

- Lock your watercraft each time it is stored.
- Keep the area clean and free of trash.
- Respect neighboring rack users.
- Launch and retrieve your watercraft safely.
- Report any damaged racks or safety concerns to Durham Parks & Recreation.

Please do **not**:

- Store paddles, life jackets, carts, trailers, or other personal belongings on or around the racks.
- Leave equipment outside of your assigned storage space.
- Modify or attach anything permanently to the racks.
- Use another person's assigned rack.
- Block access to the launch or walking paths.

Storage Season

Season Opens: August 1, 2026

Season Ends: October 12, 2026

All kayaks, paddleboards, locks, and personal property must be removed by the end of the storage season. Items left after the deadline may be considered abandoned and removed by the Town.

Important Reminder

Storage is **at your own risk**.

The Town of Durham is **not responsible** for loss or damage resulting from theft, vandalism, weather, flooding, falling branches, normal wear and tear, or other unforeseen events.

Safety First

Before heading out:

- Always wear a properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket (PFD).
- Check weather and river conditions before launching.
- Paddle with a partner whenever possible.
- Carry a whistle or other sound-producing device.
- Tell someone where you're going and when you expect to return.
- Respect wildlife, other boaters, and shoreline property owners.
