Transportation from ORMS and Mast Way to Moharimet will be provided. Daily activities will be engaging, fun and outdoor focused, with time to play freely and explore. Participants will have the option to participate in special nature-based enrichment programs, which will change seasonally. This program will utilize the Moharimet gym, cafeteria, playground, Sugar Shack and surrounding woods for daily activities.

About The Program:

Durham Parks & Rec and Seven Rivers are excited to offer a robust After School Enrichment Program for families in the Oyster River School District! Choose from our nature based activities throughout each season (fall, winter, spring) to craft a part time or full time weekly experience throughout the 26/27 school year. Our program will include a combination of outdoor projects/ activities & games that teach skills and build community.

Daily Schedule:

3:30pm- School Dismissal-Gather & check-in

3:45pm- Brief group activity (social emotional and/or team building & snack)

4:00pm- Daily Activity

5:30pm- Family pick-up



PROGRAM COST:

Administrative Fee: \$10/per child, per seasonal session

Program Fee: \$35.00/day

Enrichment Program Options: \$45.00/day

Discount: A 10% discount will be applied for full week registration per session.

Registration is required for each seasonal session. Families will have the option to pay in full or be billed monthly for registered days per session



REGISTRATION:

Step 1: Create a (or login to your) RecDesk account: durhamrec.recdesk.com

Step 2: Go to "Programs" and check "After School" (on left hand side of the page). From there you can check off the seasonal session and days per week you are looking to enroll your child.

Step 3: Select the appropriate daily program for your child. Please note: If you have multiple children that you are registering for the SR after school program, please be sure to select the correct child per day/program as grade restrictions may apply.

Step 4: At check out select pay deposit for all Seven Rivers after school program days in your cart. You will be invoiced for the remainder of the balance which you can either choose to pay in full or pay monthly installments throughout the seasonal session. **Please note: your invoice will include the seasonal session admin. fee of \$10.00 per child per seasonal session (waived if paying in full for session).**

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ENRICHMENT PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Paddling:

Explore the Upper Lamprey River in this introduction to paddling. Students will learn basic paddle technique & water safety, while enjoying this quiet section of river and the diverse wildlife of its ecosystem. All equipment is provided. After school transportation to the Piscassic Boat Launch in Newmarket is provided. Participant Pick-up is at the Piscassic Boat Launch, Newmarket at 5:30pm. **This program will remain on-site at Moharimet School during inclement weather days**

Archery:

Participant will learn the basics of archery which include range safety and proper shooting technique in a fun environment that also fosters focus, increased self-confidence, and team building skills. All equipment is provided.

Indoor Rock Climbing:

Challenge your physical limits and develop climbing skills with this 7 week indoor climbing program. Instruction and all equipment is provided. Indoor climbing will take place at UNH NH Hall. Transportation will be provided from Moharimet School, to climbing gym and back for each class.

XC Skiing:

Learn the basics of Cross Country Skiing! This program is a great way to explore the surrounding woods during the winter season. Students will be introduced to the basics of XC skiing and can warm up around the fire in between runs! All equipment provided.

Fishing:

Participants will learn the basics of fishing along with proper technique of catch and release. Participants will be transported to a variety of local fishing locations for this program. Pick up will be at the reservoir near the UNH Observatory for this program. All equipment is provided.

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Wildcraft:

This program will introduce students to a variety of 'wildcraft' skills including fiber arts, carving and clay work. In addition to creative expression with natural materials, we will explore different tools and techniques for working with wool, wood and clay.

Woodland Walks:

Explore the many Estuary watershed trails during these woodland walks! Become familiar with the dynamic plant and animal life of the seacoast and learn the basics of map reading and using a compass.

Medieval Knights:

This local favorite is a great way to become immersed in a rich historical time period. Using handmade wooden swords, participants will experience the technique, skill and impulse control needed to safely engage in sword play.

Primitive Skills:

Introducing students to fire and shelter building, making cordage, wilderness medicine and more! Students will enjoy learning these timeless skills in addition to the importance of interdependence and community through games and activities.

Cooking & Carving:

A Seven Rivers classic! Students will explore the basics of carving and whittling in this introduction to making things like spoons and other small crafts. We will also enjoy preparing and cooking a different snack over the fire each week.

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Cancelation Process & Refunds

- To cancel or make changes to your after school program registration please email the P&R office at: recreation@ci.durham.nh.us.
- A full refund or credit will be given if the request to cancel a SR After School program has been submitted 2 weeks prior to the start of a session.
- Once the session has begun, a 50% credit only will be given if the request to cancel is submitted with a two week notice.
- Once the session has begun, no credit/refund will be give if the request to cancel a program is submitted with less than a two week notice.
- Requests to add after school days once registration has closed require a notice of five business days before requested start date.



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
