

Woodridge Park Pickleball Court Rules

- Courts are available from dawn to dusk.
- Court use is first come, first serve open play unless reserved by Parks & Recreation.
- No lessons, leagues, or tournaments without approval from Parks & Recreation.
- Player rotation when courts are fully occupied:
 - 1.) Waiting players will place their paddle from left to right in a designated paddle area.
 - 2.) Court time is limited to 3 games to 11, winning by 2 (winners stay on for 3 game max).
 - 3.) Limit warm up to no more than 5 minutes.
 - 4.) Exit court after your game.
 - 5.) To play again place your paddle in the designated paddle area.
- Please report any maintenance concerns to Parks & Recreation.
- Do not use the courts when wet.
- Play at your own risk.

Portable Nets:

Two portable nets are available to use on the two lined pickleball courts that don't have nets set up on them. The nets are in the court storage box which located on the court. **The portable nets need to be set up to play and broken down after play by user and should not be left out on the court when play is finished. Please do not mix or swap net pieces between the two bags. Please be sure to lock the court box back up when you are finished putting the nets away.**
